FALL 2017 NEW TEACHER SESSIONS

WED. 10/4/2017 • CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT 2 CTLE HOURS

New teachers will learn tips and techniques for establishing a positive and engaging learning environment. Participants will build a toolkit of strategies for effective routines, procedures and classroom set-up. **(Rm 19G)**

WED. 10/11/2017 • IEP 101 2 CTLE HOURS

New teachers will explore the Individualized Educational Program (IEP), a document that provides information to ensure that students with disabilities receive the necessary support and services to succeed. Learn the process for creating an IEP, define the components of an IEP, and understand how to use the IEP to prepare effective instruction. **(Rm 19G)**

THURS. 10/19/2017 • ARE YOU ASKING THE RIGHT QUESTIONS? 2 CTLE HOURS

New teachers will gain valuable questioning strategies to promote students' thinking and learning. Learn what constitutes quality questioning and effective discussion in order to actively engage students in productive discourse. Understand how to create structures so that all students are able to answer and ask quality questions. **(Rm 19G)**

WED. 11/1/2017 • THE POWER OF FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS 2 CTLE HOURS

New teachers will learn how to determine how well their instruction is impacting student learning. This session will focus on how to use formative assessments to check for understanding to guide student learning and instructional practice. **(Rm 19G)**

THURS. 11/9/2017 • STUDENT ENGAGEMENT: TOOLS TO CREATE POSITIVE CHANGE 2 CTLE HOURS

In this session, new teachers will explore key factors that contribute to positive relationships with students and consider their implications in the classroom. Using the lens of Universal Design for Learning, strategies for engagement will be examined and opportunities will be provided to apply those strategies. **(Rms 19D-E)**

WED. 11/15/2017 • GETTING IT DONE: MASTERING THE ART OF TIME MANAGEMENT AND ACHIEVING GOALS

This session is designed to help educators set a professional goal and create a plan for success. Participants will learn how attitude, beliefs, and a growth mindset can impact achievement. **(Rm 19G)**

THURS. 11/30/2017 • PENSION: START TO PLAN FOR YOUR FUTURE
