
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT


It is hereby stipulated by and between the respective parties in the above-entitled matter that the arbitration is settled under the following terms and conditions:

1. The United Federation of Teachers hereby withdraws the Demand for Arbitration and the grievance in the above captioned matter with prejudice.
2. Grades K-3 are not to be "Departmentalized" except as set forth in item 3 below. If a school with elementary grades wishes it may "Departmentalize" grades 4, 5 and/or 6, only by posting an ELA and/or Math position to teach these subjects for a particular grade or grades in accordance with Article 7C of the Teachers' Collective Bargaining Agreement.
3. Any other "Departmentalization" requires a properly ratified and approved School Based Option in accordance with Article 8B of the Teachers' Collective Bargaining Agreement.
4. Decisions about grade departmentalization must be made prior to teachers filling out preference sheets so that teachers are aware of the options to be chosen from. The DoE will timely notify appropriate schools of this requirement.
5. The parties agree that the execution of this Stipulation of Settlement shall not be construed as an admission of wrongdoing by any party.
6. The parties agree that this Stipulation of Settlement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties in settlement of this grievance.
